## How Seats, Drivers, and Vehicles Work

#### **Adding and Removing Drivers or Vehicles:**

Per-Driver Subscription:

- Linking a driver occupies a seat.
- Delinking a driver frees up a seat for another driver.

Per-Vehicle Subscription:

- Linking a vehicle occupies a seat.
- Delinking a vehicle frees up a seat for another vehicle.

#### **Unlimited Flexibility for Non-Seated Entities:**

- Per-driver subscriptions allow unlimited vehicles.
- Per-vehicle subscriptions allow unlimited drivers.

# **Subscription Billing Explained**

#### **Initial Seat Selection:**

At the start of your subscription, you selected the number of seats based on either drivers or vehicles, depending on your subscription type.

#### **Delinking Does Not Affect Charges:**

Delinking a driver or vehicle frees up a seat for reuse but does not reduce your subscription

charges.

#### **Adjusting Your Subscription Costs:**

To reduce your charges, you must update your seat count in the Billing section.

Until you make this change, you can link and delink drivers or vehicles as needed without impacting your monthly or annual charges.

- Add more seats before peak periods to avoid disruptions when onboarding new drivers or vehicles
